He has served as Attending Physician in Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Children's Hospital of Philadelphia from 1993-2010.

Andrew is a graduate of Columbia College of Columbia University and of the Mount Sinai School of Medicine. He completed his residency in Pediatrics at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia followed by a Pediatric Gastroenterology Clinical Fellowship and a Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Cellular and Molecular Physiology at New England Medical Center.

Andrew is Adjunct Associate Professor of Pediatrics in the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine, Associate Professor of Pharmacy at the University of the Sciences in Philadelphia and Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Maryland School of Medicine.
